James Gerraty

Peter Stoker

He is the current Chairman of the Joint Ore Reserves Committee and was Secretary from late 1999 to 2005. He is also a member of Committee for Mineral Reserves International Reporting Standards (CRIRSCO). He was a member of the Steering Committee and a contributor for Monograph 23 "Mineral Resources and Ore Reserves Estimation - The AusIMM Guide to Good Practice" and has authored or co-authored a number of papers on Mineral Resource and Ore Reserve estimation, classification, exploration research and practice.

Geoff Turner

Geoff Turner is a Registered Professional Geologist with the Australian Institute of Geoscientists. He has served as a Councillor to that Institute since 2002 and has served on the Recognised Overseas Professional Organisations (ROPO) Taskforce, being a sub-committee of the Joint Ore Reserves Committee (JORC).

Geoff's academic qualifications included a B.Sc(Hons) from the University of Adelaide, a M.Sc (Mining & Exploration Geology) from James Cook University of Nth Qld, and a Grad. Certificate in Ecology & Groundwater Studies from University of Technology, Sydney.

Geoff has over 30 years experience in mineral exploration during which time he held senior exploration management positions in West Australia and Victoria, principally in gold exploration, and operates his own exploration management company, Exploration Management Services Pty Ltd.
