### **Bruce Fulton, BSc, MSc (Hons), MBA, MAusIMM, MAICD**

Bruce is a geologist and business developer with 20 years experience within the Australian and South East Pacific resources sector across a number of commodity groups including gold, copper, and coal. He is currently Managing Director with Swann Global, an executive search firm specialising in the global mining and resources industry. He is Chairman of the Sydney Branch of the Australian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy and a Non-Executive Director with ASX-Listed Universal Resources.

Bruce commenced his career in the Western Australian Goldfields where he was employed in various technical roles with a variety of organisations including St Barbara and Dominion Mining and Plutonic Resources. He worked offshore for Placer Dome at their Porgera operation in Papua New Guinea, where he was ultimately responsible for the geological teams efforts during a time of significant gold production and significant reserve increases. He has extensive experience in exploration and mining, corporate development and M & A work for a number of Australian and international companies.

### **Kate O'Rourke**

Kate O'Rourke is a Senior Manager in the Corporations team at ASIC. This team is responsible for operational and project-based work at ASIC relating to corporations, including mergers & acquisitions, schemes of arrangement, fundraisings, continuous disclosure, corporate governance and financial reporting. Prior to this she was a senior lawyer in the policy team, an area responsible for developing ASIC's regulatory guidance to the market.
